- \* Those who apply for associate professorship or full professorship are exempted from presenting transcripts.
- \* All the within-five-year publications presented should have been published; otherwise applicants should provide a statement indicating when the said paper will be published. Enclose reviewing statement, if any.
- \* The letters of recommendation should be sent directly from the writers to the address below prior to the deadline on **December 31, 2018**.
- \* The dossier will not be returned afterward.
