General Guidelines for the 3rd International Conference of HCIA

These guidelines are for the conference participants (presenters, chairpersons, and discussants) to establish expectations.

- 1. The entire conference will be conducted in English.
- 2. The presenter will be briefly introduced by the chairperson of her/his session before presentation.
- 3. **Presentations**: There are **30 minutes** for each presentation. If a presentation ends early, the remaining time will be moved to its discussion time. Each presenter will be reminded with a short bell ring at the last **3 minutes** and twice while time is up. After the presentation time expires, the bell will ring every **30 seconds**.
- 4. **Discussions**: After all presenters of each session have finished presenting, there will be 20-30 minutes for discussion (in principle, each presenter can be allocated **10 minutes** for discussion). Discussants are allowed up to **5 minutes** to speak. The bell will ring once in the last **30 seconds** and twice while time is up to remind discussants of the time.
- 5. The chairperson may appropriately adjust the end time of the session based on the special circumstances of the session she/he is responsible for without affecting the overall agenda.
- 6. The application software and link URL used for online presentation will be announced separately.
